We are committed to our continued care of all our staff and guests and will continue to monitor the situation closely and follow the advice of our local and national agencies in regard to our response.

Our Commitment to Illness Prevention

- All guest will to continue to receive full service. Disinfect all beds, tables, chairs, counters, doors, door handles, sinks, water fountains, light switches, and other touchpoints. Vacuum and mop every day where needed as needed
- Daily rounds will continue, and additional rounds may be added if needed.
- All restrooms will be cleaned and disinfected as many times as possible every day.
- Dining Hall will be disinfected after each meal or group activity, Camp Wrightwood staff will continue a high standard of cleanliness and hand washing.

As you consider your attendance at Wrightwood, we ask the following:

If you are feeling ill, please stay home.

We are providing additional on-site hand-sanitation and washing stations. Please use them! If you become symptomatic while on our site, please inform our staff immediately and quarantine vourself.
